

BRIEF OVERVIEW AND RELEVANCE

To support their mission, the Navy planned to acquire a 25-acre parcel of land adjacent to NRC New Orleans in Plaquemines Parish from a private landowner. Jacobs completed an ECP Assessment to evaluate the environmental status of the site, including swampland portions, to better understand potential liabilities associated with the purchase.

PROJECT SCOPE

- Historic Aerial and Satellite Imagery Review
- Stakeholder Interviews (Private and Government)
- Site Inspection
- Draft (60-day) and Final (90-day) ECP Report

CHALLENGES

The Navy tasked the team with completing the assessment within a condensed 90-day timeframe to allow for a quick turn property acquisition.
