



## BRIEF OVERVIEW AND RELEVANCE

To support their mission, the Navy planned to acquire a 25-acre parcel of land adjacent to NRC New Orleans in Plaquemines Parish from a private landowner. Jacobs completed an ECP Assessment to evaluate the environmental status of the site, including swampland portions, to better understand potential liabilities associated with the purchase.

### PROJECT SCOPE

### CHALLENGES

The Navy tasked the team with completing the assessment within a condensed 90-day timeframe to allow for a quick turn property acquisition.

### KEY ACCOMPLISHMENT

Worked under an accelerated timeframe, completing the site visit within 15 days of project award and preparing a high-quality draft report that required no revisions, allowing the Navy to proceed with property acquisition 30 days ahead of schedule.
